Robalo R305 Walkaround

THE 30-FOOT R305 WALKAROUND OFFERS THE LOOK, feel and handling of a bigger, 35-foot-class vessel. This “pocket yacht” sports a roomy 10-foot, 6-inch beam with comfortable seating on deck plus sleeping accommodations for six. The R305 has been carefully designed to provide maximum comfort for cruising without compromising ergonomics or fishing features.

Robalo has installed two livewells with a total capacity of 55 gallons. Both insulated wells feature the Dual Vortex recirculating system and red LED lighting and are gel-coated blue to maximize live-bait health. Two insulated fish boxes provide nearly 200 gallons of capacity for bringing home fresh fish and keeping extra ice cold.

The bow area sports an integrated anchor-roller system and a stainless Lewmar windlass, galvanized Delta anchor, chain and 200 feet of rode. The windlass comes with convenient foot switches at the bow and a hand toggle on the dash. Robalo also installed a handy washdown system inside the windlass compartment for easy cleanup.

Access the foredeck through the locking cabin hatch or the spacious walkways port and starboard, lined with safe, convenient handholds.

The helm area comprises every captain's dream — all operating systems fall within easy reach, and critical

instrumentation lies in direct line of sight. The navigation panel uses digital systems and can accommodate a pair of 12-inch screens with room to spare. Robalo placed controls for the standard Lenco trim tabs with LED indicators directly adjacent to the binnacle-style

engine controls. The R305 also features standard power-assisted hydraulic steering.

On the port side, passengers sit on an L-shaped bench that easily converts to a comfortable aft-facing lounge and features an insulated icebox beneath the seat cushion.

The cockpit floor opens to reveal all onboard pump systems, the electrical grid and optional 4.2-kW diesel Panda generator. On deck behind the folding rear seat, a hooded compartment lifts up, revealing access to batteries and master switches. Fuel manifolds are also located here to direct flow from the standard 245-gallon fuel tank and the optional 51-gallon reserve.

In the aft cockpit, Robalo has configured horizontal storage for six rods; four more can be stored on the hardtop; and six more may be placed in rod holders. To port, an expansive bait prep and rigging station includes a freshwater sink, cutting board, tackle storage, knife and pliers holder and removable Plano drawers.

A wide transom door reveals a hot or cold freshwater shower, raw-water washdown and a three-step ladder that hides inside the hull when not in use. This ladder can be easily deployed by someone in the water, adding an invaluable measure of safety.

Inside the cabin, the upscale décor includes a stainless-steel refrigerator, stove and microwave, maple cabinets and teak and holly laminate floors. The V-berth filler converts to a solid-teak galley table. The V-berth seat backrests tilt up and lock, converting to bunk beds and revealing spacious storage behind bungee-laced netting.

The aft berth offers sit-up headroom, and the head and shower compartment features a VacuFlush head with optional overboard discharge, hot and cold sink and shower, spacious storage and a full-length mirror. •
